



MOST SNP



Most SNP, also known as the UFO Bridge, is one of the most iconic landmarks in Bratislava, Slovakia. This impressive structure spans the Danube River, connecting the Old Town of Bratislava with the district of Petržalka.

Construction of Most SNP began in 1967 and was completed in 1972, during the era of Czechoslovakia's communist regime. The bridge was designed by a team of architects led by Ján Lacko, and its distinct shape and futuristic appearance have made it a symbol of Bratislava's skyline.

The UFO Bridge stands out for its unique design. Its main feature is a soaring pylon that supports a flying saucer-shaped observation deck, which gives the bridge its popular nickname, the UFO Bridge. This observation deck, known as the UFO Tower, sits 95 meters above the ground and offers breathtaking panoramic views of Bratislava and the surrounding area.
